Cookie Policy

This cookie policy explains how **INVOIZ INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED** ("we", "us" or "our") use cookies and similar technologies to recognize you when you visit our websites at www.invoiz.world ("Websites"). It explains what those technologies are and when we use them, as well as your rights to control our use of them.

In some cases we may use cookies to collect personal information, or that personal information if we combine it with other information. In such cases our privacy policy <https://invoiz.world> will apply in addition to the cookie policy.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. Cookies are widely used by website owners in order to make their websites work, or to work more efficiently, as well as to provide reporting information. Cookies set by the website owner (in this case **INVOIZ INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED**) are called first party "cookies". Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called "third party cookies". This party cookies enable third party features or functionality to be provided on or through the website (e.g. like advertising, interactive content and analytics). The parties that set these third party cookies can recognize your computer both when it visits the websites in question and also when it visits certain other websites.

Why do we use cookies?

We use first and third party cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons in order for our websites to operate and we refer to these as "essential" or "strictly necessary" cookies. Other cookies also enable us to track and target the interests of our web users to enhance the experience on our online products. Third parties serve cookies through our websites for advertising, analytics and other purpose. This is described in more detail below.

The specific types of first and third party cookies served through our websites and the purposes they perform are described below (please note that the specific cookies served may vary depending on the specific online properties you visit).

What about other tracking technologies, like web beacons?

Cookies are not the only way to recognize or track visitors to a website. We may use other similar technologies from time to time, like web beacons (sometimes called "tracking pixels" or "clear gifs"). These are tiny graphics files that contain unique identifier that enable us to recognize when someone



has visited our websites. This allows us, for example, to monitor the traffic patterns of users from one page within our websites to another, to deliver or communicate with cookies, to understand whether you have come to our websites from an online advertisement displayed on a third party website, to improve site performance and to measure the success of e-mail marketing campaigns. In many instances, these technologies are reliant on cookies to function properly, and so declining cookies will impair their functioning.

How can I control cookies?

You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject cookies. You can exercise your cookie performance by clicking on the appropriate opt-out links provided in the cookie tables.

You can set or amend your web browser controls to accept or reject cookies. If you choose to reject cookies, you may still use our website though your access to some functionality and areas of our website may be restricted. The means by which you can refuse cookies through your web browser controls vary from browser to-browser, you should visit your browser's help menu for more information.
